High Praise for A(n) _____: Ode

An **ode** is a type of lyric poem (poems in which the speaker shares personal thoughts and feelings on a subject) that highly praises something – usually a person, an event, or an idea. Traditional odes are about serious subjects, and they have a formal tone.

Directions: For this assignment, you will write a free verse ode on a subject of your choosing. Here are some guidelines for your poem:

1. The topic may be humorous or tongue in cheek, as Neruda’s is, but the ode should express high praise of its subject.
2. You must include at least one simile, metaphor, and example of personification in your ode.
3. You must include imagery/sensory language in your ode.
