The PowerPoint presentation must include the following:

- A minimum of 10 slides
 - Title
 - References
 - 8+ slides of information (Use the accompanying Endangered Species Plan)
- Relevant pictures
- Color and Neatness (Do not just use a plain white background. Use one of the PowerPoint themes)
- All researched information (When researching at least 2 facts about your animal, you can earn extra credit (up to 3 points; 1 point per fact) on your project by adding more facts)
- A logical sequence of information

As you work on this project, your teacher will check on your progress **daily**.
