Dear CRHS School Community:

On Friday, Aug. 6, Gov. Murphy announced that effective immediately, the New Jersey Department of Education will **require** all New Jersey K-12 school district employees, students, and visitors ages 2 and older to wear masks indoors at schools, regardless of vaccination status. Please be advised that the Cumberland Regional School District is enforcing this mandate **as directed by the State**, and face coverings are required to be worn by all staff/faculty/administrators, students, and visitors at Cumberland Regional High School and the Cumberland Regional Board Office at this time.

As the delta variant of the COVID-19 virus continues to spread, the district reminds all members of our school community to utilize safety precautions and practices to reduce transmission risk:

- Cover your mouth and nose with a properly fitting face mask when in public settings or around others. Always cover your mouth and nose when coughing or sneezing.
- Wash your hands regularly with soap and water, and/or clean your hands regularly with alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- Maintain at least six feet of distance between yourself and others whenever possible.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Monitor your health, be alert for symptoms of illness, and stay home if you feel unwell.
- Practice physical distancing by avoiding unnecessary travel and staying away from large groups of people.
